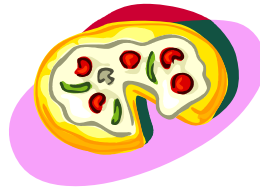

Cold and Flu Season Information

Now that cold and flu season is upon us and many students have been showing symptoms of illness, we want to remind you about Capitol School's illness policy:

If your child has a non-clear runny nose, yellow or greenish discharge, it is usually a sign of infection and s/he should not be sent to school. Children will be sent home unless a physician has determined that the condition is not contagious to the rest of the students.

We'll send a child home with a 100.4 fever and they will need to be fever-free for 24-hours without the aid of Tylenol.



Parents, or an authorized person, will be notified immediately when a child has signs or symptoms of illness, and prompt pick up is required (parents will be contacted first).
